

Firdapse® (amifampridine) - Updated dosing

- On May 30, 2024, the <u>FDA approved</u> updated dosing for Catalyst Pharmaceuticals' <u>Firdapse</u> (<u>amifampridine</u>), for the treatment of Lambert-Eaton myasthenic syndrome (LEMS) in adults and pediatric patients 6 years of age and older.
- For adults (any weight) and pediatric patients (45 kg or more), the maximum dose was increased from 80 mg to 100 mg.
- For pediatric patients weighing less than 45 kg, the maximum dose was increased from 40 mg to 50 mg.
- For complete dosing and administration recommendations, refer to the Firdapse drug label.
- Firdapse is available as a functionally scored 10 mg tablet.



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
