

EstroGel[®] (estradiol) – First-time generic

- On April 25, 2024, Solaris launched an [AB-rated](#) generic version of Ascend Therapeutics' [EstroGel \(estradiol\)](#) 0.06% transdermal gel.
- EstroGel is approved for the treatment of moderate to severe vasomotor symptoms due to menopause, and for the treatment of moderate to severe symptoms of vulvar and vaginal atrophy due to menopause.
- EstroGel carries a boxed warning for endometrial cancer, cardiovascular disorders, probable dementia and breast cancer.
- Estradiol is also available generically as a [vaginal cream](#), [0.1% transdermal gel](#), [transdermal system](#), and [vaginal insert](#). Additional forms of estradiol are available: oral tablet, injection and in combination with progestins.
 - Estradiol vaginal cream is approved for the treatment of moderate to severe symptoms of vulvar and vaginal atrophy due to menopause.
 - Estradiol transdermal gel is approved for the treatment of moderate to severe vasomotor symptoms due to menopause.
 - Estradiol transdermal system is approved for the treatment of moderate to severe vasomotor symptoms due to menopause, and for the preventions of postmenopausal osteoporosis.
 - Estradiol vaginal insert is approved for the treatment of atrophic vaginitis due to menopause.
